As you may be aware, TPAs are required to meet a number of requirements to maintain certification, and they are as follows:


- The payment of an Annual Professional Fee (invoice attached).
- A minimum number six (6) audits in the province of Alberta, following the jurisdictional requirements for submission of completed audits.
- You may also be required to retake the course material and examination should there be a significant change in legislation or audit procedure, at no charge.

Your certification will begin once we receive payment of the Annual Professional Fee and will remain active for one (1) year.
